1. RULES

3. CLASS RULES

Each Class will be governed by the applicable One Design Rules pertaining to that Class. Entries of three or more boats will constitute a Class.

4. CLASSES

Classes will include Optimist, Sunfish, Lasers, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Club 420's (2 person), and Rhodes 19s (3 person)

5. ELIGIBILITY

1. All competitors must be members of US Sailing, or their Member National Authority, or
2. Members of a Yacht Club or Community Sailing Program.

6. FEES

1. The entry fee will be \$50 per boat, or \$35 per person double-handed.
2. Boat Charter fees will be as follows: (free for SCYC members)
Optimist: \$ 50
Sunfish: \$ 50
420: \$ 80
*Unfortunately, we do not anticipate having Lasers or Rhodes 19's available for charter.
3. Damage Deposit: \$200, refundable at the end of the regatta if no damage was incurred.
4. Fee includes lunch Friday and Saturday and regatta t-shirt.
