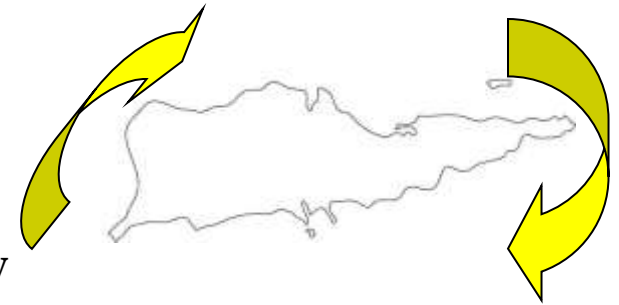




**NOTICE OF RACE**  
*Around St. Croix Race*  
*& Powerboat Rally*  
**St. Croix Yacht Club, Teague Bay**  
**January 28 and 29, 2012**



**1 Rules**

The race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009 -2012. The management of the race shall be by the designated race committee of St Croix Yacht Club which shall have the authority to decide all matters relating to this race. . The rules of the road apply. All powered vessels should keep clear of the sailing vessels.

**2 Registration and Schedule of Events:**

Friday, January 27,  
Saturday, January 28,

1800: Registration at SCYC in east room  
0700: Continental Breakfast SCYC  
0730: Skippers' meeting – starting times assigned  
0900: First Warning Signal (Sailboat Start)  
0930: First Warning Signal (Motor Rally Start)  
1600: Celebration @ Coconuts on West end.

Sunday, January 29,

0700: Continental Breakfast & Breakfast Burritos at Coconuts  
0900: First Warning Signal  
0930: First Warning Signal (Motor Rally Start)  
1600: Celebration at the YC

**3 Racing Area and Course:** The course will be from the starting line off of pull point, around St. Croix clockwise, beginning and ending in the vicinity of Pull Point, on St. Croix's north shore. The race will finish Saturday and start Sunday in the vicinity north of the end of the pier, on St. Croix's West end. The starting and finish line in Frederiksted will be due west from flag on a committee boat. Leave all aids to navigation, including Hovensa channel markers, to starboard except yellow park bouys. There is a fixed can marker to mark the turn off of Sandy Point. The starting and finishing line off of Pull Point will be between a flag on shore and a tetrahedron.

**4. Starting and scoring:** The race will be run in a Pursuit format with each boat's starting time determined by its median PHRF handicap; each boat's finishing place will be its position in that race; races will be combined to determine awards to the top three finishers in each class. One or two classes are anticipated based on the range of handicaps for participating boats.

**5. Fees:** \$40 for Yacht Club members; \$50 for non members.
