


For those brave and energetic souls working out on must now pay Jennifer it being billed through the club. Please continue to sign-up for the class online.

The club has purchased a new Point of Sale system in order to better serve you, as well as track profit and loss, overhead, and food/alcohol costs. In the past there was some confusion as to knowing where and when to pay for which purchases and services. This system will alleviate that problem as all club charges will come on one monthly bill which will be due monthly. For those who prefer to run a "tab", you will need to have a credit card saved on file with the club, so that confusion over bill due dates go away. For those members who prefer to "pay as they go", there will be no requirement of having a credit card saved with the office. 



